IPRATROPIUM BROMIDE (ATROVENT ®)

Ipratropium Bromide (Atrovent ®)

Protocols:

1. Nebulized Bronchodilators

Indications:

- 1. Bronchial asthma
- 2. Bronchospasm in emphysema
- 3. Chronic bronchitis
- 4. Other wheezing in adults and pediatrics

Contraindications:

- 1. Hypersensitivity to ipratropium bromide
- 2. Hypersensitivity to atropine or its derivatives

Dosing:



- 1. Adult: 500 mcg/3 ml combined with Albuterol 2.5 mg/3ml, nebulized
- 2. Pediatric: For children aged 5 or under, Ipratropium 250 mcg should be given

Expected Effects:

- 1. Decreased wheezing
- 2. Decreased respiratory distress

Side Effects:

- 1. Palpitations
- 2. Dry Mouth
- 3. Anxiety
