## Personal Protection During Treatment of Patients to Limit the Spread of Airborne Infectious Diseases

**Purpose:** To establish expectations of EMS personnel when providing patient care that could either expose the patient or personnel to airborne infectious diseases, focusing primarily on the use of masks.

- 1. When the use of masks by EMS personnel or patients is described in this protocol it is specific to surgical masks. N-95 masks are not required, but personnel or patients may wear them if they choose to do so.
- 2. EMS personnel are required to wear masks when the following circumstances exist:
  - a. Patient is experiencing any respiratory illness
  - b. Patient is immunocompromised
  - c. Patient is positive for COVID-19
  - d. At the request of the patient or patient's family
  - e. At the request of a sending or receiving facility
- 3. Patients should wear masks (if it can be tolerated) when the following circumstances exist:
  - a. Patient is experiencing any respiratory illness
  - b. Patient is positive for COVID-19
  - d. At the request of the patient or patient's family
  - e. At the request of a sending or receiving facility
