Welfare Checks

Did you know that Genesee County 911 handles on average about 6,500 requests for welfare checks a month. 6,500!! Approximately 5,500 of those are handled by law enforcement without an EMS response. The remaining 1,000 involve EMS crews.

In a recent review of 911 and GCMCA data it was found that 70% of welfare check calls EMS responded to resulted in the patient being transported. This is relatively close to the total volume of calls. On average 76% of EMS dispatches of all types are transported to the hospital with the remainder being cancelations, refusals, and DOS.

While welfare checks can sometimes be frustrating and feel like a waste of time, this data shows that EMS is making a difference and there is more often than not a need for medical attention.
